What Can We Do to Eliminate Bullying in School?

A note from Principal Anne O'Toole



It would be comforting if I could tell you that bullying does not exist at Robious Elementary, but I wouldn't be telling you the truth. The truth is, just as at every other school in this country, we have our share of bullying. Unlike many other schools, however, the signs of bullying in our school may be well-hidden. Instead of outright fist fights, we may have notes being passed silently in class threatening to exclude a classmate from a game at recess. Instead of making fun of a classmate, we may have a student refusing to allow a classmate to sit next to him on the bus. The students at Robious Elementary are very bright, and some of them have become masters of hiding bullying behaviors from the adults in their lives, including their parents and teachers.

So, what can you do to insure that your child does not become a bully and is not bullied by others?

1. Teach your child the correct way to stand up for himself/herself at school. The steps are very simple and work for every age. If someone is doing something that makes your child feel uncomfortable, your child needs to ask the person to stop. If the behavior continues, your child needs to say, "If you keep doing that, I'm going to tell an adult." If the person continues, your child needs to leave the situation and immediately tell an adult. You, as a parent, should expect that adult to respond by investigating the situation—not taking your child's accusation as gospel and not taking the other child's word as gospel—but rather, listening to the facts on both sides and meting out a consequence where bullying has occurred.
2. Don't be fooled into thinking that your own child would never bully another child. If your child shows a talent for leading others, make sure that you are teaching your child the difference between being a positive leader and being a bully. Most of the students I encounter who exhibit bullying behaviors have leadership potential, but they have parents who have great difficulty accepting that their child needs to alter his/her behavior at all. Let your child know in no uncertain terms that you will not accept him/her coercing others and provide a memorable consequence if your child does bully, then your child will get the message that you don't tolerate bullying.
3. Teach your child that it's okay to speak to adults in charge. I wonder if we haven't caused problems by warning young children not to "tattle" on others but to "work out their own problems." Children who tattle do so because they feel powerless to solve a problem. We need to tolerate the tattling while we simultaneously teach our children what to say and what to do to right the injustices they observe in their world. Many young children aren't mature enough to know what is worth reporting to an adult and what should be overlooked. It is better to have our children report too much to us than too little.

We may never totally eliminate bullying in schools, but parents and educators working together can certainly reduce the number of incidents. By being vigilant, modeling appropriate behaviors, and insisting on respect for others, we will give our children the gift of tolerance for those who are different.

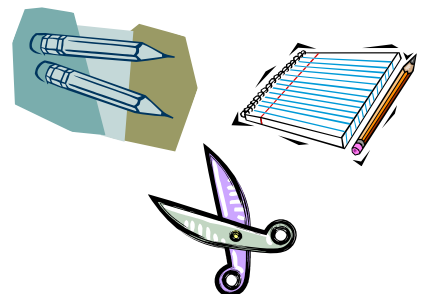
Highest Average Team Score: Team Erwin (Joe and Grace Erwin)

Green Team News



It's hard to believe that Spring is finally here, and Earth Day is right around the corner. The Green Team has been planning another exciting Earth Week for our RES students. This year, since Earth Day falls during Spring Break, we will be observing Earth Week primarily from April 25-29. I say "primarily" because we will be having our Earth Day Walking Bus on April 15. The rest of the fun comes after Spring Break.

As in years past, during Earth Week, we will be encouraging RES students to turn off their TV and spend a green hour outside each day of the week. Be sure to check your April 8 Friday folders for the TOYTV/Green Hour slips, and hang onto them! Each day that your student(s) don't watch any TV and/or spend at least one hour outside engaged in unstructured play during Earth Week, initial their slip(s) and send in to school the next day. Each day, the grade level with the highest number of hours not watching TV and playing outside will win a prize. Then, at the end of the week, the grade level with the highest number of cumulative hours will win a... PAJAMA DAY!! We will be basing all of the calculations on the % of each grade level participating, just to make sure that grade levels with more students don't have an unfair advantage.

Also in honor of Earth Day, we will be repeating our student photography display. This year, the theme will be "The Earth is Priceless". We are encouraging all of our RES students to get out in nature over Spring Break and take a picture that illustrates the theme. The picture should be no larger than 5x7, should be mounted on paper, and should include a short caption written by the student explaining how the photo relates to the theme. We'd also love it if your student would include a name and grade level on the submission. Check your April 8 Friday folder for a small flyer about this initiative.



The Trex recycling challenge has gone well. We didn't count the bags turned in individually, but based on the rule of thumb that one 30-gallon trash bag will hold 1,000 plastic grocery bags, we believe that this drive has kept well over 10,000 plastic bags out of the landfill (this number doesn't include what we hope to collect the week of student-led conferences). We will provide another update after all the collections are complete.

On a somewhat less happy note, I'm afraid I have bad news about the juice pouch recycling program. TerraCycle changed their rules to only accept pouches in quantities of 500 (it used to be 100). Apparently, there is a magic point somewhere between 100 pouches and 500 pouches where ants become aware of a potential feast, and they came sniffing around our juice pouch collection bin. That's not a good thing, so we have removed the collection bin from the school. We have provided our feedback to TerraCycle about why we will no longer be participating in this brigade, and we will continue to monitor their program to determine if it might become a good fit again someday. In the meantime, we hope to expand the number of "dry good" brigades in the classroom. We already collect spent glue sticks/bottles and hope to also start collecting writing instruments and scotch tape dispensers in the not too distant future.



And in closing, thanks to all the families that participated in the March Walking Bus. It was a good turnout on a beautiful morning. Our walking bus marveled at the forsythia blooming all around. We would love to hear what you marveled at!

In Case of Inclement Weather

At the beginning of each school year, families should make emergency closing child-care arrangements so that students know what to do and where to go if schools close early.

If it becomes necessary to close schools because of bad weather or for any other reason, such as power failure, announcements will be carried on the school system's web site (chesterfield.k12.va.us), made on Comcast Channel 96, submitted to local radio and TV stations or communicated via ParentLink.

Chesterfield schools use ParentLink to communicate with parents via phone or e-mail. So that this communication tool can work effectively, parents need to make sure their school has their correct phone numbers (home, work and cell) and e-mail addresses. In addition to emergency closing information, ParentLink is used to notify parents about children's absences and to share information about upcoming school events.
